The FA Cup & Tadley-Calleva

THE FA CUP - AND TADLEY-CALLEVA

The FA Cup has long been considered and established as the most famous and prestigious Club Cup Competition in Football. Todays Extra Preliminary Qualifying Round includes no fewer than ten all Wessex League Ties – greatly decimating the League's involvement at this early stage of the competition. One such tie is our own as we welcome Baffins Milton Rovers to Barlows Park for what is their debut in The FA Cup.

In 2013/14 we made our own debut in the FA Cup being beaten 3-0 by Hellenic League side Ascot United. This was also the first FA Cup game to be held at Barlows Park. Incredibley, were then awarded the tie and reinstated into the competition due to the opposition fielding an ineligible player. This led to us visiting Ryman League side Chalfont St. Peter where we were not disgraced by any means, finally losing the tie 5-3 in front of fantastic travelling support. Amazingly, the draw for the 2014/15 season sent us again to Ascot with the tie finishing all square at 1-1. In the resulting replay of the tie, Ascot United proved the much stronger side and we went down 4-2.

2015/16 and Combined Counties League Guildford City were the visitors to Barlows Park. The game was a very tight affair which we were unfortunate to lose 3-2. 2016/17 saw a Sunday visit to Hellenic League side Highworth Town on the outskirts of Swindon. The game was played on a pitch that sloped sharply from goalmouth to goalmouth. We managed to take the lead and largely controlled the game until conceding two soft goals that left us to return home empty handed. Last season our entry was not accepted but we are back in the competition and stronger than ever. The winners of todays fixture will be rewarded with a home tie against the rapidly climbing Hartley Wintney in the next round.

Ties for the Preliminary round will be play on Saturday 25th August.

On Tuesday night Baffins Milton Rovers made the short journey across the M27 to face AFC Porchester. The visitors were behind with 20 minutes to go when M.Davies equalised to make it 1-1. AFC Porchester hit back instantly, going 2-1 ahead in the 73rd minute. The game looked out of reach for the visitors but an equaliser at the death from J.Mclean secured a point on the road for Baffins Milton Rovers.

Founded in 2011, Baffins Milton Rovers FC are a newly founded club from Portsmouth. The club was originally set up as two Sunday sides, Milton Rovers and Baffins Milton, both of which found success in the Portsmouth Dockyard League and Meon Valley League over many years.

The club was formed by Yvonne Fradgley-Smith who remains at the heart of todays visitors. Yvonne has put her heart and soul into the rise of Baffins Milton Rovers FC and whilst others have come in to drive the club to the position they are today, it must be noted that, without Yvonne, Baffins Milton Rovers FC would not exist.

During the 2015/16 season, Baffins Milton obtained a grant to secure new floodlights that provided the platform for entry into higher level football, Step Six criteria. This allowed BMRFC to progress into the Wessex League. BMRFC were rewarded with promotion to the premier league and a cup final appearance all within their first season. A great achievement from all involved.

Baffins Milton Rovers are a local club with 100% players living within the Portsmouth area, funded by Portsmouth businesses, controlled and operated by people within the Portsmouth area, a true community club that will continue its successful growth for years to come.

Further honours include the Hampshire Premier League title in 2013/14 & 2015/16, Hampshire League Cup winners 2013/14, Portsmouth Saturday League title 2011/12 & Portsmouth Senior Cup Winners in 2013/14 & 2015/16

Last season BMRFC finished in 9th position of the Wessex Premier Division.



The Season So Far...

Tadley Calleva 3 Fareham Town 1 Saturday 4th August 2018

With a solid pre-season behind us it was time to get down to business in our first season in the Wessex Premier Division. We welcomed Fareham Town to Barlows Park in the blistering sunshine with 5 of our squad making full competitive debuts. Harry Pearson, Chad Abrams, Elliot Parker, Elliot Amadieu And Simeon Howell all made their first appearance for the club.

With first team manager Danny Dolan away, Brian Drury took charge of the side who eventually ran out 3-1 winners.

Fareham started the strongest of the two sides and scored within 2 minutes after a cross from the right hand side was converted perfectly past goalkeeper Freddie Gee.

5 minutes later Tadley were on the attack, a half chance resulted in a corner which was met by Danny Vickers. Agonisingly, his effort cannoned off the bar keeping the score at 0-1.

After the break Tadley started to copmpletely dominate the game. Three minutes in the crossbar again came to Fareham's rescue. This time a header from Tadley skipper Shaun Dallimore.

Tadley continued to push forward and the introduction of Brett Denham changed the game completely. Tadleys talisman, within 5 minutes set up Sam Hamilton for the equaliser. 3 minutes later Denham was on the scoresheet, heading the ball into the back of the net. The game was wrapped up in injury time when the ball was turned home by Simeon Howell follwowing a scramble in the 6 yardbox.

Tadley made it two wins out of two on Tuesday night after an emphatic 3-0 win under the floodlights.

The visitors got the game underway but didn't start in the fashion they would've wanted. After just 3 minutes a shot from Danny Vickers from around 30 yards whistled narrowly past the woodwork.

After this chance Tadley knew they could get at the young defence. Many chances followed in the first half however the majority lacked conviction and both teams went into half time level at 0-0

As the game m oved into the second half, Tadley really started to play with confidence within the final third. This was rewarded just two minutes into the half when a long throw in was flicked on leaving Brett Denham to chest the ball home.

In the 71st minute a swinging cross from Parfitt found it's way to Denhamwho managed to get infront of his man and net his second of the game. This took his tally to 3 already this season.

Tadley wrapped up the tie after a long ball from goalkeep er Gee was flicked on by the BHH centre half. Cameron George was able to capitalise on this error and flick the ball with his head around the oncoming BHH goalkeeper leaving the ball to run into an empty net.

This win gave tadley 6 points out of 6 leaving us 2nd in the table behind Sholing on Goal Difference.



The History

In brief

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League.

The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two.

The club changed it's name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also very successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd positions in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at the Soccer AM Stadium (formerly 'The Camrose') after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had it's best run in the FA Vase last season reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Premier Division. They also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup last season losing out 3-1 to Premier Division side Whitchurch United - again at The Camrose.
