# First Half Blitz!

Our first goal came when Alex Charlick made a fine run down the left wing and crossed for Scott Kinge whose first time shot flew under the bar. This was quickly followed by a second when James Tennant burst into the box and squared the ball perfectly for Brett Denham who turned his marker and fired home.

On twenty minutes, the inevitable third goal followed, after a great run by Brett Denham who took the ball to the bye-line before pulling it back for Paul Coventry to make no mistake.

It was all Tadley at this stage with the home defence in complete disarray, desperately appealing for offside decisions, but getting caught out time and again. James Tennant made it four after Chris Morris slotted a superb ball into his path and he made no mistake from 12 yards.

The fifth goal soon followed after Brett Denham was pulled down in the box and the resulting penalty was neatly dispatched by Paul Coventry for his second goal of the match.

The second half saw Whitchurch put in a dogged and determined effort to keep us at bay, but we continued to create several chances without showing the same clinical touches as before the break. The home side did pull a goal back through a break away by Taurean Maunders. We had a strong appeal for a penalty waved away as Brett Denham was tripped in the box as he was setting up to shoot and a late effort from Sam Hamilton went narrowly wide after some great build up play with Darryl Phillips. Fine goalkeeping from Freddie Gee did prevent the home side from snatching another from Jack Ormiston late on as we appeared to take our foot off the pedal somewhat. But there is no denying this was an impressive three points that took us to the top of the table over the Christmas period.

# Alton FC

---

## Today's Visitors

We welcome our visitors to Barlow's Park today with them having suffered a hefty 4-0 defeat at Totton & Eling in their last outing before Christmas. This result is symptomatic of the inconsistency they have shown this season, yet they remain in touch with the leading pack sitting in eighth place - six points behind ourselves.

Our visit to Alton in November seemed to be going well for us after an OG and a goal from Danny Vickers gave us a comfortable 2-0 half time lead. All credit must go to Alton as they stormed back after the break with three goals to snatch the points - two from Sean Hayes and one from Callum Burch. We will certainly be looking for a better result today.

The present Alton FC was formed in July 2016 with the merger of Alton Town and Alton United Youth. This came about after years of negotiations with the brewery regarding the Bass Ground.

Alton Town was formed in 1990 when two senior clubs, Alton Town and Bass Alton amalgamated. Alton Town had been fantastically successful, winning everything in Hampshire in the period 1948-1958, including Hampshire League Divisions 3, 2 and 1, the Hampshire Intermediate Cup & Russell Cotes Cup in 1949 and the Hampshire Senior Cup in 1958.

Although they dropped back to Division 2 in 1954-55 they bounced back immediately. They then stayed in Division 1 until 1973 to join the Athenian League Division 2 which they won in their first year. After an initial period of success the club found itself unable to compete and dropped down to the Combined Counties League before returning to the Hampshire League in 1984.

Bass Alton started life as Courage & Company (Alton) and joined the Hampshire League in 1928-29. The following year they were in Division 2 and won promotion to Division 1 where they stayed before being relegated to Division 2 in 1938-39, just before the club was disbanded for the war.

Since the amalgamation, the club has played in the Hampshire League and achieved promotion to the Wessex League by topping the Premier Division in 2002 before moving to the Combined Counties League from season 2013-14.

In 2014-15, the club reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup - narrowly losing out to Hungerford Town after extra time.

Season 2015-16 saw Alton Town back in the Wessex League after re-organisation of Step 6. Last season they finished in 12th place in Division 1.

# Title Chase on?

Good afternoon and welcome to Barlow's Park for today's Sydenhams Wessex League Division One match. A particularly warm welcome is extended to the players, officials and supporters of Alton FC and also to today's match officials.

It was a massive disappointment to all when last weekend's game against Folland Sports was postponed, despite our best efforts to get the pitch ready, as we were hoping to maintain or position at the top of the table - achieved as a result of a crushing 5-1 win away at Whitchurch United in our previous game.

So several crucial games today and none more important to us than the visit of our nearest geographical neighbours Alton FC. We will be hoping to reverse the 3-2 defeat we suffered back in November after leading 2-0 at the break.

The second half continued in a similar fashion with Scott Kinge seeing his shot get deflected wide. From the resulting corner Shaun Dallimore headed the ball back across goal finding Andrew Charsley whose header was pushed onto the bar and over by keeper Tewksbury.

Brett Denham was next to go close as he met a well flighted Alex Charlick free-kick, but steered his effort narrowly past the post. This was soon followed by another crucial save from Tewksbury to deny Shaun Dallimore - making him a strong contender for MOTM.

We continued to press and Christchurch full-back Will Gage was well placed on the line to keep out a clever lob from Scott Kinge - whilst Paul Coventry turned his marker inside out, but saw his shot yet again fly past the far post.

It was a very frustrating for the lads which was epitomised in the final minutes, when Scott Kinge, having been harshly booked in the first half, was shown a second yellow for a late challenge.

However, each and every player can certainly feel proud of the effort they put into the game and, if anything like this form can be maintained, our challenge for a promotion spot should remain well on course.

# The History

## In brief

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League.

The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two.

The club changed it's name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also very successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd positions in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at the Soccer AM Stadium (formerly 'The Camrose') after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had it's best run in the FA Vase last season reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Premier Division. They also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup last season losing out 3-1 to Premier Division side Whitchurch United - again at The Camrose.
