# FA Vase - A future trip?

The 2017-18 FA Vase kicks off today with the First Qualifying Round involving 220 ties of 440 club. This means that, in theory, any club involved could meet any of the other 439 clubs. But, in practice that is obviously not the case.

With clubs competing from the length and breadth of England, the FA adopts a form of regionalisation to avoid extremely lengthy travelling. This largely works, though many leagues feel that regionalisation is too narrow with clubs far too frequently drawn against clubs from their parent league. So take the regionalisation away and just who could you be up against? Well it could be one of the following (selected at random purely because of their unusual name).

WEST ALLOTMENT CELTIC FC who sound like something from a Scottish Gardeners Question Time and are based in North Tyneside. They play in the Northern Football League Division Two. The club could sadly be on the brink of folding as they rent their ground from the Northumberland FA who intend to increase the rent for next season by over £3000 - with a further review promised for the following season. This, I'm afraid, is rather typical of the treatment of clubs at this level by the Football Authorities.

Moving across to Merseyside and to LITHERLAND REYMCA FC who joined the North West Counties

League Division One in 2014-15. The unusual second part of their name comes from a long ago merger between Rem Social Club and Bootle YMCA. At this time last season they defeated the august sounding City of Liverpool FC.

Heading south to Nottingham now and the East Midlands Counties Football League side CLIFTON ALL WHITES. This is a long time youth set up that embraced adult football in 1973 and lists Gary Birtles & Jermaine Jenas amongst its former players. Not surprisingly they play in an all white strip. GRAHAM ST PRIMS FC, as the name suggests, has religious connotations having been formed in the early 1900's to play in a Sunday School League by members of the Prim Methodist Church, Graham Street in Derby. They folded in the early 1990's, but reformed four years later and now play in the East Counties Midland League.

Finally (for now) we go to the East End of London and SPORTING BENGAL UNITED FC who play at the Mile End Stadium in Tower Hamlets. The club was formed as recently as 1996 to provide football for the Asian Community and is 'operated' (whatever that means) by the Bangladesh Football Association.

So by winning enough games a visit to one of the above could be on the horizon!

# Bashley FC

## Tonight's Visitors

Bashley come to Barlow's Park this evening sitting in 15th place in the Wessex League Premier Division and although they scored six in a recent Bournemouth Senior Cup tie recently, their league form has been inconsistent with two wins and two draws from their opening nine games.

On Saturday they were defeated 5-1 by Andover Town despite taking a ninth minute lead through Ben Bolton. Kabba Jack was last season's top scorer and he has started this campaign in similar style with 4 goals so far.

The club was founded in 1947 and joined the Bournemouth League in 1950 - progressing through the ranks before leaving in 1983 to join the Hampshire League.

In 1986 they became founder members of the Wessex League and won the title for the first three years that they took part, 1986-87, 1987-88 & 1988-89.

In the 1987-88 season Bashley came to national prominence after an incredible run in the FA Vase. It came to an end in the semi-final, losing narrowly to Emley in the second leg after a 0-0 draw at the Recreation Ground.

Following their 3rd Wessex League title, the club were accepted into the Southern League Southern Division and amazingly won the title in their first season - gaining promotion to the Premier Division.

Things almost got even better the following season as Bashley led the table for a long period of time and were in contention for promotion to the Conference League, but fell away towards the end to finish in fourth place. Sadly the meteoric rise of the club came to an end as result of relegation two years later back to the Southern Division.

There followed a topsy turvy period where the club enjoyed both highs and lows, but at the end of a disastrous 2013-14 campaign they found themselves close to going out of existence.

Hard work behind the scenes from club officials ensured this didn't happen, but the club continued to struggle on the field and were relegated to the Wessex League following a 2015-16 season without a single win and a mere two draws.

Last season the club finished in 14th place of the Wessex Premier Division.

# Archie Says... Relax

On Saturday, a hard fought victory at Beatrice Avenue saw us gain three vital points to maintain our unbeaten league run. The hosts, with a much changed side from last season and a couple of recent new signings making their debut, made a real game of it and in the end it was our quality finishing that proved the difference between the teams.

The first half saw us have the greater possession, but for the first 35 minutes neither keeper was really called into any serious action. We were denied a stonewall penalty after 37 minutes when Darryl Phillips was clearly brought down inside the box by Harrison Berry, but the referee waved play on - and not helped by his assistant who was dead in line with the incident.

We continued to press and just minutes later were rewarded when a fine attacking move saw us take a deserved lead. Darryl Phillips swung in a fine ball that picked out Brett Denham on the far side of the box. He outpaced his marker and squared a beautiful ball across the box for Connor Thorne to finish. We came close to adding a second in the 44th minute when a superb long range strike from Alex Charlick was turned brilliantly round the post by home keeper Dan Russell.

After the break we continued to press, but Vics were enjoying more possession and looking more dangerous - prompted by debutant Alex Przespolewski and skipper Dexter Malin. Kieran Greene kept us in front with a fine save to deny Ji Nash on 60 minutes.

Midway through the half the threatened equaliser arrived when the impressive Przespolewski played a neat one-two before chipping the ball over keeper Greene. We still looked dangerous going forward though and with 5 minutes remaining we took the lead after a superb curling free-kick from Archie Fawcett was fckicked on by Brett Denham giving Russell no chance. That lead was extended with another excellent finish when Jason Kingston found Archie Fawcett in space who cut inside and fired a brilliant strike inside the near post. Two magical moments from Archie seemed to have sealed the points although Vics did pull a goal back in the dying seconds when a free-kick from Przespolewski flew into the net. Needless to say Manger Danny Dolan was delighted to have come away from the island with the three points.

# The History

## In brief

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League.

The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two.

The club changed it's name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also very successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd positions in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at the Soccer AM Stadium (formerly 'The Camrose') after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had it's best run in the FA Vase last season reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Premier Division. They also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup last season losing out 3-1 to Premier Division side Whitchurch United - again at The Camrose.
