Today's Visitors

We welcome Holyport FC to Barlow's Park today in the first ever meeting between the two clubs. It should prove to be a closely fought affair with both teams looking to move away from the foot of the table.

Holyport FC was formed in 1897 at The George Inn located in Holyport. Initially they played in the Maidenhead & District League and their home ground was at Windsor Road, Bray.

At the beginning of 2002-03, after 3 very successful seasons, Holyport were promoted to the Hellenic League Division 1 (East) and 2 seasons later they moved to their current ground at Summerleaze Village in North Maidenhead. Several years of hard work resulted in the ground meeting FA requirements to compete at Step 5 level football.

Their continuous improvement, both on and off the pitch, have contributed to progressing the club's ambition of playing in the FA Vase and FA Cup which they achieved in 2008 & 2010 respectively.

The 2010-11 season was historic for Holyport. In their first season the management team of Derek Sweetman, Kevin Carvell and Calvin Maye led the side to the Hellenic Division 1 (East) title, the AM Print & Copy Floodlit Cup and the Bluefin Insurance Challenge Cup.

The 2011-12 season saw Holyport finish a very respectable 13th in their debut season and also as semi-fanalists in the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup & League Supplementary Cup.

2014-15 saw Martin Kenealy step aside after 12 months in charge and the committee made the decision to step back down to Division 1 (East). The side had a steady season in 2015-16, but season 2016-17 was a struggle. In 2017-18 ex-player Matt Rolfe was appointed as assistant to Barry Rake and the club finished in 5th position in the league.

Rake resigned in the summer of 2018 and current boss Derek Sweetman was appointed assisted by Rolfe, Ovens and Deverall. The 2018-19 season produced another good FA Vase run and again finishing 5th in the league.

The following two seasons were cut short due to Covid-19 and after o long wait the FA decided to average out both seasons and Port were promoted to the new Step 5 league, finishing 3rd based on PPG.

Hit For Six...

Tadley Calleva 0 Wembley 6 Combined Counties League - Premier Division (North) Saturday 13th November 2021

After a several good performances and results in the league recently, this one took all of us by surprise.

Although we had exited the North Hants Senior Cup in midweek at the hands of old Wessex League rivals

Alresford Town, we were quietly confident of maintaining our league form....how wrong were we?

It would be fair to say we also made made more than a significant contribution to our own downfall.

The management team made several changes to the squad with goalkeeper Craig Atkinson, striker Ryan Stephens and full back Aiden Harris all returning from injury and added to the starting line up. With Brad Neal on holiday, Andrew Charsley moved back to his familiar central defensive position. Skipper Tom Walsh was unavailable due to illness.

The game itself started fairly evenly, but also a bit flat with both teams failing to test either goalkeeper in the opening minutes. However, the pattern for the remainder of the game was set after the visitors took the lead on 16 minutes. A mix-up at the heart of the Tadley defence allowed Samuel Adetiba to tap into an empty net. It was soon 2-0 to the visitors when again Tadley failed to deal with a simple cross. The ball made it's way across the 6-yard box to Quasim Khan who couldn't believe his luck for another tap-in goal after only 20 minutes. The next goal would be crucial. However, a serious injury to Scott Kinge on 42 minutes, after a horrendous looking challenge by Jermaine Heron, saw him taken

to A&E as the afternoon went from bad to worse. To the astonishment of the majority of people in the ground the referee saw the challenge only worthy of a yellow card. The half time whistle soon followed with Wembley the happier of the sides going in at the break. (HT 0-2)

The home support were looking for a reaction at the start of the second half, but unfortunately it didn't materialise and the game was effectively over on 53 minutes. Heron was left unchallenged in the box and he got on to the end of a corner to side foot home. To rub salt into the wounds a misplaced pass straight from the resulting kick-off saw Heron play in Khan for his 2nd of the match.

The best goal of the game was scored on 65 minutes when substitute Jahara Krubally cut inside and rifled the ball home from 20 yards out leaving Atkinson with little chance. As much as the Tadley side tried, at least to grab a consolation goal, it was just not to be and the visitors capped a fine afternoon by scoring a breakaway goal in the 90th minute. Alvin Walters outstripping the Tadley back line to fire into the roof of the net.

The History

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League. The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two.

The club changed it's name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also very successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd position in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at The Camrose after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had it's best run in the FA Vase in season 2015-16 reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (loW) from the Wessex Premier Division.

They have also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup in the last two seasons; losing out 3-1 to local rivals Whitchurch United in 2016-17, again at The Camrose, and then 5-4 on penalties to Andover New Street in 2017-18 at Longmeadow after a 3-3 draw in normal time.

The club achieved it's ambition of gaining promotion to the Wessex League Premier Division last season - the highest level (Step 5) that the club has competed at. The goal is to consolidate its position on the field and to make significant progress with the infrastructure off the field.
