

A Happy New Year!

With today being our first fixture of 2019, we decided to take a look back over the past five seasons to see how we fared in the same fixture.

Before we do, a quick summary of our last two away fixtures of 2018; We travelled to Bemerton Heath on December 22nd and came away with a 2-0 win. New signings Wat Jones and Ross Cook made their debuts. Top scorer Brett Denham opened the scoring on 32 minutes before Cook got our second four minutes later. Unfortunately Cook was sent off early in the second half, but we held out to take the three points.

Last Saturday we went down 3-1 away at Shaftesbury. A disappointing result as we were looking to push on from our previous good results. Again we had a man sent off, Shaun Dallimore for two cautions. However, on a positive note, Brett Denham kept up his scoring record by getting his name on the score sheet again.

So back in time; 2013-14 when the horrendous weather meant that we did not play a game until the 1st March 2014 - January and February were completely washed out. So the nearest fixture to the New Year was when we travelled to Ringwood Town on Saturday 28th December. We came away with a 2-0 win courtesy of two goals from Brett Denham. Our 16 man squad that day included brothers Tol and Tam Solonye.

2014-15 was marginally better in terms of the weather as it was the 24th January before our first fixture. A 4-0 win over Laverstock and Ford at Barlow's Park secured the points. Two goals from Brett Denham and one each for

Scott Kinge and Ben Wickens. In that season we narrowly missed out on promotion with Cowes Sports as runners-up and Team Solent taking the title.

2015-16 saw us make the long journey to New Milton Town on the 16th January. We returned home with a share of the points with James Tennant scoring our goal in a 1-1 draw. We again finished in 3rd position missing out on promotion to Portland United and Amesbury Town who finished in 1st and 2nd spot respectively.

2016-17 was probably our worst ever result for many a year when Hamble Club came to Barlow's Park on Saturday 7th January and left with an 8-2 win. Brett Denham and Scott Kinge scored our goals that day. Hamble Club did run away with the title that season scoring over 100 goals - they took 7 from Folland Sports, 8 from Alton Town, 9 from Romsey Town and 14 against the luckless East Cowes Vics. We finished in 7th position.

Finally 2017-18 when we eventually achieved promotion to the Premier Division that we had threatened for several seasons. New Year was marked in spectacular fashion when we defeated Alton 6-1 on the 6th January. Brett Denham was again the main marksman for Tadley with four goals and one each for Paul Coventry and Darryl Phillips.

The rest, as they say, is history!

So on to today's match - we are hoping for a home win, but whatever the outcome a happy, healthy and prosperous New Year to you all.

Today's Visitors

Bashley will be hoping for a repeat of the score line when we visited the New Forest back in August when they won by 4-0. This was our first defeat of this season and although the home side were worthy winners, the scoreline was a bit harsh on us. Tony Rolls, Cameron Beard and two from Dan Munday did the damage in front of a crowd of 136.

Founded in 1947, Bashley FC joined the Bournemouth League in 1950 and left in 1983 to join the Hampshire League. In 1986 they became founder members of the Wessex League and won the title for the next three seasons. In 1987-88 Bashley reached the semi-final of the FA Vase losing narrowly to Emley.

In 1989 the club joined the Southern League Southern Division and won the title in their first season. The following season, in the Premier Division, they were in contention for promotion to the Conference League before finishing in 4th spot. The club's rise came to an end two years later when they were relegated back to the Southern Division.

Bashley reached the FA Cup 1st Round proper in 1994-95 and won 1-0 at Chesham. A 2nd round home tie

with Swansea ended in a 1-0 defeat - nearly a major upset. In 1997 they appointed European Cup Winner Jimmy Case as manager and were again in contention for promotion before finishing 3rd.

Young midfielder Wade Elliott signed for AFC Bournemouth in January 2000 for £5000, with Bashley receiving appearance money. Elliott subsequently signed for Championship side Burnley.

The club spent many years in the Southern League with several illustrious names taking the managerial hot seat with some successes before relegation saw them return to the Wessex League for the 2016-17 season. Their full history can be viewed on the club website; www.bashleyfc.org.uk

Last season they finished in 14th position of the Wessex Premier Division with Conor Whiteley their top scorer with 17 league goals.

They play their home games at the Recreation Ground, Bashley Road, New Milton, BH25 5RY. They are also affectionately known as 'The Bash' by their loyal band of supporters.

Alresford Town continued their recent good form with a 2-1 away win at AFC Portchester. The New Forest derby saw Brockenhurst defeat Lymington Town by 3-2 in front of a crowd of 233. Bemerton Heath bounced back from losing to ourselves by beating Andover New Street by 4-0. Finally Baffins Milton Rovers kept their title aspirations alive by beating Cowes Sports by 3-1 on the Isle of Wight.

We also made some new additions to the squad over the festive period; Ross Cook joined us from Hartley Wintney, Wat Jones signed from Amesbury Town and Kieran Maylen made the transfer from AFC Aldermaston. Welcome to the club lads!

A Point to prove?

Tadley Calleva 1 Sholing 1

*Sydenhams Wessex League Premier Division
Tuesday 11th December 2018*

After a two week break due to postponements, Tadley Calleva welcomed league leaders Sholing for our final home match of 2018. The table-toppers were on a 16 game winning streak in the league and were hoping to avenge a 1-0 loss at Barlow's Park in the Wessex League Cup earlier in the season.

Tadley were without captain Shaun Dallimore, midfielder Danny Vickers and top goalscorer Brett Denham - so we had a few notable absences.

With nine minutes on the clock, Freddie Gee was called into action as he made a good save from a Lee Wort header. Gee was again called into action minutes later when he made superb saves from Mason and Cuthbertson. Tadley's first real chance came on twenty minutes when Connor Thorne worked Ryan Gosney in the Sholing goal.

Lee Wort was a bit of a handful for the Tadley defence and Gee was on hand again to keep the score at 0-0. Sam Hamilton had an opportunity for the home side just before half-time, but his effort went straight into the arms of keeper Gosney. This was the last real action of the half as the sides went in level at the break.

Tadley came out fast at the start of the second half and, after 2 minutes, Cameron George picked up the ball around the half way line, drove forward and his effort

smacked against the crossbar. However, the home side didn't need to wait too long for the opener. On 52 minutes George Hallahan picked up a through ball from Luke Neller and he curled his shot wide of Gosney into the far corner of the net. Tadley then looked to double their lead as a corner from the right found the head of Andrew Charsley, but his effort went just over the bar.

Unfortunately for us, Sholing's scoring prowess paid off after 71 minutes. The league's top scorer, Dan Mason, added to his 33 goal tally by poing the ball home from a very tight angle after a hotly disputed free-kick. Gee was called into action on 80 minutes as he stopped Mason from grabbing his second goal of the night.

The final 10 minutes were fairly quiet as the home side were content to be the first side take a league point from a very strong Sholing side. Manager Danny Dolan was delighted with his sides attitude and performance on the night. That's two games undefeated against a very good team likely to take the Premier Division title.

The History

In brief

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League. The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995-96, gaining promotion to Division Two.

The club changed its name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007-08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also very successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd positions in both seasons.

In the 2010-11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thattham Town 4-1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at The Camrose after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had its best run in the FA Vase in season 2015-16 reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Wessex Premier Division.

They have also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup in the last two seasons; losing out 3-1 to local rivals Whitchurch United in 2016-17, again at The Camrose, and then 5-4 on penalties to Andover New Street in 2017-18 at Longmeadow after a 3-3 draw in normal time.

The club achieved its ambition of gaining promotion to the Wessex League Premier Division last season - the highest level (Step 5) that the club has competed at. The goal is to consolidate its position on the field and to make significant progress with the infrastructure off the field.
